

Div 1 Industrial Cup Round 1: Henley Town 3 v 4 Bethel United

Henley Town goal 3-3: again Henley fought back and managed to get a third and force extra time.

4th Bethel Goal 3-4: Henley Town's keeper did very well to reach another excellent Mark Montgomery free-kick that was heading into the top corner, however he was unable to hold onto the ball and **Paul Alexander** was quick to pounce and nudge the ball over the line in dying minutes of the

game and secure the victory for Bethel.
